AJIT KAMBIL

Dr. Ajit Kambil is the global director for research at Deloitte's CFO program. As the creator of Deloitte's Executive Transition Labs – he serves and helps leading client CFOs, CIOs and other C-suite executives frame their go forward priorities and plans to effectively navigate a new leadership role. Since June 2010, Deloitte has delivered over 1000 CFO transition labs, and Ajit has personally helped over 220 leading CFOs across twenty countries transition to their new role. As research director he oversees diverse research initiatives of the CFO Program. He created CFO Insights a fortnightly publication with over 35000 subscribers, and oversaw development of CFO Lens – Deloitte's App for CFOs and other finance executives. Ajit previously led Deloitte Research - a global think tank. In addition to his work with CFOs, from time to time he undertakes unusual client work such as helping a country develop its science, technology and innovation strategy. Before Deloitte, Ajit was an Associate Partner at Accenture's Institute for Strategic Change (now High Performance) where he led diverse research initiatives in eCommerce, supply chains and innovation. As faculty in information systems at NYU's Stern School of Business, he led the NSF sponsored program pioneering the dissemination of corporate disclosures on the Internet beginning in 1994 and pioneered eCommerce courses in the MBA and executive MBA programs.



Dr. Kambil is widely published across diverse fields in leading business and technology journals including: Harvard Business Review, Sloan Management Review, IEEE Computer and Communications of the ACM. His last book Making Markets was published by Harvard Business School Press. He holds a PhD and other degrees from MIT.
